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Children's Lives Include Moments of Bravery

CLIMB[®] is a new support program at the June E. Nylen Cancer Center **for children ages 5 to 13 whose parents or other close family members are diagnosed with cancer.** Through art projects and discussion, this structured program helps normalize feelings of sadness, anxiety, fear and anger in the children and nurture positive communication between them and their parents.

The closed support group meets evenings once a week for six weeks. Dinner is provided at the beginning of each session.

Session topics include:

- All About Me
- What is Cancer?
- It's OK to Feel Sad
- Cancer Can Be Scary
- It's Not Fair!
- I Love You (Graduation Ceremony)

The CLIMB program is offered **free of charge** because we firmly believe that stronger families make stronger survivors. Facilitators are specially trained by The Children's Treehouse Foundation, a non-profit organization **dedicated to the emotional support of children** who have parents with cancer.
